My name is Faryad Illyas. **My family and I have been in the brickyard making and baking bricks for many generations.** I have been doing this since very young as a child.

We never thought that God would love the weakest people like us. But through sister Aneela, God's daughter, **we have seen God in our lives.** God loves us so much, He has kept us alive to this day that we come before Him and bow before Him. We are grateful to God for all His blessings.

I have four children. My wife and I work all day on the brickyard and then we get 2 meals. **My wife has a medical problem.** She cannot work very hard because she has a disease. She also has joint pain.

It is difficult to feed all family members because I work alone, so we have to borrow money for my wife's medical treatment and often for food. The money we borrowed from the owner is about \$832. We have not been able to pay it off to be free from the slavery.

If we could be free from the slavery of the brickyard, we can get work outside at a factory. We can live in a rented house.

Please remember us in your prayers so that we may be free from the bondage of brickyard and give honor and glory to the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen!
