## CONSIDERING SUICIDE

### *You can help*

**Aneela Zia**, our missionary in Pakistan, met **Irfan Misah** with his family of four (Father, Mother and two sons) at one of the many slave brickyards in Pakistan.

This family have been **stuck in slavery for years**. Their condition is **so miserable that words can't describe it**. Irfan was burnt badly because of his baking the bricks in the brickyard kiln oven. (Note picture)

The family has been hungry for days.

They are being **tortured daily** by the guards of the brickyard kiln owner.

Irfan told us that they are so weak and tired that **they can't make the required 3000 bricks each day**. **His wife is very sick and cannot work**. The Muslim kiln owner has an eye on his wife. He talks vulgarly toward her and touches her, and Irfan can do nothing about it.

## MATTHEW 25:34-40 (ESV)

Then the King will say to those on his right, 'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

For I was hungry, and you gave me food, I was thirsty, and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me,

Irfan and his wife were planning to commit suicide by hanging themselves to the ceiling. They can't bear it anymore. They have no strength left.

They are Christians. *Aneela has been visiting and comforting them with the love of Christ and brought them food and told them not to lose hope in Christ.* She encouraged them that a breakthrough is near. She prayed with them. *Irfan said they would keep trusting God, but he does not know for how much longer.*

If we are able to get Irfan and his family out of the brickyard, *he will live temporarily with his cousin's brother until he can get a good job.*

Because he was so badly burned, he can not do hard work. So Aneela and her team will help him get a small ice making business cart that costs **\$520** to make ice balls to sell on the streets.

The debt he owes is **\$1392** because his father died when he was 8 years old. His mother did everything she could but because she is a woman in a Muslim society, she could not make enough to provide food for her son. So, she worked with the Muslim brickyard owner and *Irfan began making bricks at 8 years old to survive.* His mother died 2 years ago. The brickyard owners only provide basic food and a place to stay in a corner of the brickyard. *Making bricks is never enough to pay for his living expenses, which might include medicine, clothing, etc.* His debt can never be paid off.
