## SICK BUT HAS FAITH

### *Give them new start*

Greetings! My name is **Shakeel Ghama**. I am a brickyard slave since I was a child. My ancestors also worked on brickyards. They died but I am still working on this brickfield. I have 2 kids. **I am a patient of CLD (Chronic Liver Disease).**

Sister Aneela joined us in prayers and told us that all of you pray for us in the brickkilns. She always helps us to grow in faith and teaches us to have faith in Him.

I cannot work much. I must visit a doctor frequently but mostly I am not able to buy medicine because of money. I have had to borrow \$637 from the brickyard owner. Because **I cannot get enough money for medicine, this increases my pain.** Our brickyard owner only pays us every 8 days. Even if some emergency happened to appear within this time, still we do not get money. **We do not get a single leave from work.**

I have a daughter and a son. They are both 4 years old. My wife is skilled in sewing. If we can get released from the brickyard, she will sew clothes if she gets a sewing machine. I will sell fruits/vegetable on a cart. We will live in a house for rent.

Debt: \$637  
Fruit cart will cost \$600.  
Sewing machine: \$125  
Processing cost – bank fees transfer, transportation and setup \$100.  
Total: \$1462

Please join me in prayers also pray for my health. **For if Jesus Christ can raise the dead, He can also heal me.** I wish to get released from this brickyard to have a lively existence.
