End the Nightmare

Greetings in the mighty name of Jesus Christ. **My name is Shamaoon Muntazir.** I am 17 years old. I have been working at the brickyard since the age of 5. I don't know about my parents. But one of my uncles cares for me and willing to take care of me where he lives. But because I am stuck in the curse of brickmaking, I cannot go to him.

One day working at the brickyard, **a cart full of bricks fell on me.** God saved my life, but my leg was injured, and **I cannot walk well.** It was the duty of the brickyard's owner to take me hospital, but he didn't. Some of my fellow workers took me to the hospital where the doctors did surgery on my leg. I had to take out a loan to pay for this and I am now unable to pay it back. After the operation I was able to walk slightly. Now I cannot work anywhere else.

My uncle's sons are willing to give me space in their house, but I can't join them without paying my debt to the brickyard owner.

Please pray for me that I may pay off the debt and be released because doctors say that I will remain in my condition the rest of my life. I am sad because I know that nobody will marry me to help me in my physical care. My uncle's children will be my support and stand with me, but they are not able to pay my debt to the owner.

Please pray that I can be free from this life of slavery. My debt is about \$713. I can do a vegetable cart for a mini business. The cart cost about \$600. I need \$50 transportation from Brickyard. Total \$1363.

Keep praying that I may get out of this **terrible nightmare.**
